Community Style Acupuncture **uses a Social Business model**, designed to generate social dividends rather than financial dividends, and generally re-invest all profit back into community acupuncture with jobs, and creating accessibility to acupuncture in our community.

▫ **Sliding Scale fees range \$10 - \$35 per full treatment; you decide what you can pay. We'll never ask for income verification. Grand Opening Special during November and December 2011, We are waiving the \$10 paperwork fee.**

▫ Patients are treated in zero-gravity lounge chairs in an open clinic setting. We use white noise to reduce sound, or you can bring your own music while listening with earphones. The open clinic experience fosters an incredible relaxing and healing environment. No need to disrobe; we only need to be able to have access from the knees down and the elbows down. Health details are held confidential.

▫ Similar to most types of bodywork, acupuncture treatment has an accumulative effect. Treatments need to be received frequently and regularly, especially for chronic and complex conditions. The purpose of the sliding scale is to help you get the treatments you need. It's important to us that you get results and feel better.

▫ Only new, sterile, hair-fine thin, FDA approved, disposable acupuncture needles are used.
